

Ramaiah University of Applied Sciences (RUAS) was established as a Private University under an Act passed by the Government of Karnataka. RUAS is sponsored by Gokula Education Foundation (Medical), a Public Charitable Trust of the M.S. Ramaiah Family. Envisioned as a modern as well as innovation-intensive University, RUAS is engaged in interacting with industry, business, communities and Government organizations. RUAS, a Comprehensive University and Unitary in nature, has pioneered the concept of outcome-based education in India. The University has implemented outcome-based curriculum with a focus on imparting to students knowledge and understanding, cognitive abilities and practical skills relevant to professional and societal needs. The University has adopted global best practices in teaching, learning and assessment to ensure all round development of students for a successful career. Its programmes are inter and multi-disciplinary in nature and designed to train students to be creative, innovative and imaginative graduates.

The University Grants Commission has granted Sec. 2(f) status to RUAS recognizing its contribution in education and research. RUAS got laurels when it was Ranked 90th, by the National Institutional Ranking Framework, Union Ministry of Human Resources and Development appreciating the quality of research and perception about the University among the stake holders. Recently, the Karnataka State University Rating Framework (K-SURF) accorded twin-status to RUAS as a Four-Star University and the Best Innovation University. QS I-GAUGE, Indian University Rating has awarded RUAS with Diamond Rating in Innovation and Gold Rating for the University overall. Leading educational and news magazines have ranked RUAS as the best, emerging, research and innovation University.

The University's operations commenced from December 30, 2013 and RUAS was inaugurated on March 18, 2014. At the time of formation of the University, the Sponsoring Body integrated the then existing institutions namely Ramaiah School of Advanced Studies (1999), Ramaiah College of Hotel Management (1993), Ramaiah College of Pharmacy (1992), Ramaiah Dental College (1991) and Ramaiah Advanced Learning Centre (2012) to constitute the Faculties of Engineering and Technology (FET), Art and Design (FAD), Management and Commerce (FMC), Pharmacy (FPH), Dental Sciences (FDS) and Hospitality Management and Catering Technology (FHMCT). RUAS has subsequently added the Faculties of Mathematical and Physical Sciences (FMPS) as well as Life and Allied Health Sciences (FLAHS).

RUAS has 8 Faculties (with 35 departments) and 9 Directorates. Its activities are broadly organized under the following four verticals, viz., Academics, Research, Training and Lifelong Learning and Consulting activities through its Techno Centre. RUAS offers 23 Undergraduate Programmes leading to B. Tech., B. Design, BDS, B. Pharm., Pharm. D., BHM, BBA, B. Com (Hons) and B.Sc. (Hons) and 55 postgraduate programmes leading to M. Tech., M. Design., MBA, MHA, M.Sc., M.Com., M. Pharm., and MDS degrees through its Academics Division. RUAS has more than 4,000 students on its roll in various programmes. More than 270 students have enrolled for the Doctoral Programme offered by its various Faculties and leading up to the Ph.D. award. The University has created 21 Research Centres to facilitate multidisciplinary research.

The University has established RUAS Innovation Centre, Ramaiah Technology Business Incubator and an Entrepreneurship Development Cell to support start-ups with funding from Union Ministry of Small and Medium Enterprises and the Department of IT, BT and ST (GoK). RUAS encourages its students to take part in international competitions, debates, sports and other cultural events. RUAS students have distinguished themselves by winning National and International Competitions and Hackathons. Equipped with state-of-the-art laboratory facilities, libraries, resource centres and having implemented proven, global educational practices, RUAS has set itself out to become a premier Innovation University of International stature in the near future.
