Departments and Academic Programmes

The faculty of Pharmacy has five departments

- 1. Department of Pharmacognsoy
- 2. Department of Pharmaceutics
- 3. Department of Pharmaceutical Chemistry
- 4. Department of Pharmacology
- 5. Department of Pharmacy Practice

Each department is an independent entity headed by a Head of the Department reporting to the Dean of the faculty. Each department has its own faculty members, teaching and learning resources and offers UG programme leading to B.Pharm degree, Pharm D degree, PG programmes leading to M.Pharm and Doctoral programme leading to Ph.D degree. Each department offers Part Time PG programme and Doctoral Programme for working professional.

B. Pharm – 4 years (8 Semesters)

The Undergraduate Programme in Pharmacy aims to impart a high-level of knowledge and skills in Pharmacy, coupled with general education. The combination of Pharmacy education and general coursework can provide a broad base of knowledge that can apply to pharmacy. The graduates produced will be able to meet the human resources requirement of pharmaceutical industry.

Pharm D – 6 years (Annual Pattern)

The course is aimed at facilitating and enabling pharmacists to fully utilize their substantial knowledge and expertise in areas such as pharmacotherapeutics, clinical pharmacy, hospital and community pharmacy. The Pharm D curriculum emphasizes patient centered course of study that develops students with skills and attitudes to critically evaluate and modify clinical practices in a timely and effective manner.

M Pharm - Full time (2 years) / Part time (3 years)

Master's degree programme of MSRUAS is designed to impart high-order overview in the chosen subject area. The postgraduates are expected to find opportunities in industries and business, research establishments and even may take up entrepreneurship. With experience, they should be able to take up leadership positions in the chosen career.

Research scholars also take time to attend and participate in seminars where current research is presented by their peers, faculty and eminent visiting scientists.

The PG programme is offered as a module system, one of its kind in India for encouraging and facilitating students to have an enriching learning experience with lessened academic burden.

Departments and Academic Programmes

Department of Pharmacognosy

Pharmacognosy is a multidisciplinary science, which deals with chemistry, biochemistry, isolation, structural determination and pharmacological aspects of drugs of natural origin. It incorporates various modern analytical techniques to authenticate and standardize herbal drugs as well as purified active extracts. The Department of Pharmacognosy is equipped with some sophisticated equipments like High Performance Thin Layer Chromatography (HPTLC) system.etc

Department of Pharmaceutics

Pharmaceutics is the discipline of pharmacy that deals with the science of dosage form design and embraces all aspects of converting a drug into a dosage form that can be safely and effectively used by patients. The highlight of this department is a pilot scale machine room designed to provide hands-on training to undergraduate and post graduate students of all streams, so that they are readily accepted in industry after the completion of course.









Department of Pharmaceutical Chemistry

The nature of competition in the industry calls for quality research and hence there is a great demand for M. Pharm. and Ph.D. students in the research and drug development in pharmaceutical industry besides teaching positions in the discipline of Pharmaceutical Chemistry. The department is equipped with a central instrument laboratory containing sophisticated analytical instruments.

Department of Pharmacology

Pharmacology is the study of drugs that examines the interactions of molecules with living systems, with a view to understand the properties of drugs, drug effects and drug receptors. It also provides the scientific basis for the use of drugs as therapeutic agents in medicine or as tools in scientific research. It is an important link between medical education and biomedical science.

Department of Pharmacy Practice

The Department of Pharmacy Practice was established in the year 2009 and is committed to excellence in education and pharmaceutical service. The department focuses on the evolution and application of the concept of clinical pharmacy in Indian scenario. The department is located adjoining the 1050 bedded teaching hospital and is equipped with all resources, comprising of fully computerized drug information center with an attached library, latest edition of Micromedex and a modernized seminar room. The department also publishes an in-house newsletter "VISTA".



Research

Research, Publications and Patents

MSRUAS has a strong focus on Applied Research. The research programmes originate from industry, research establishments and business organizations. Students can opt for Doctoral Programme leading to the Ph.D Degree either through the full time or part time route. One of the main aim at FP is academic research. Normally these groups work on research problems with collaborations and technology transfer from various institutes. The faculty members of these groups supervise Ph.D thesis also. The faculty members of these groups are assisted by other academic faculty of allied specialization areas and research assistants. The research themes are:

Pharmacognostical, phytochemical and therapeutic screening of several indigenous herbal drugs by various models; Design ,synthesis, characterization, pharmacological evaluation and biological activity of novel chemical derivatives; Formulation and evaluation of novel drug delivery systems with improved characteristics covering wide range of therapeutics; Synthesis and characterization of polymers for controlled and targeted drug delivery.

The doctoral programme offered at MSRUAS is well structured and motivated candidates will be able to complete their Ph.D in the defined period. Around ten faculty members are already pursuing their doctoral programmes in various universities with few of them on the verge of thesis submission.

Conferences, Seminars and Workshops

The faculty encourages the teaching staff and post graduate students to attend the national and international level conferences, seminars and workshops. The quality improvement programmes conducted by AICTE for the faculty members covering all the disciplines across the country have been enthusiastically attended by the faculty for keeping themselves abreast of the current trends in pharmaceutical sciences.

The students and faculty are motivated to participate in several national level conferences for poster presentation and publication of research articles in leading journals of high repute. The faculty has to its credit more than 200 publications in several reputed journals.






Collaborations, student and staff Exchange and partnerships
