

Complaints related to caste-based discrimination

In pursuance to the regulation of the University Grants Commission, New Delhi (UGC), dated 14.09.20 (D.O. No.F.1-7/2011(SCT)) to prevent/address instances of Caste Based Discrimination in Higher Educational Institutions, an online Caste Based Discrimination Complaints system (CBDC) has been developed for the use of students/teachers/Non-teaching staff of the University. They may register their grievances and concerns regarding SC/ST/OBC discrimination and any kind of caste related injustice online, so as to avail proper solutions for the inconveniences they had experienced.

Caste Based Discrimination Complaints system (CBDC) provides a platform for the authorities to curb caste-based discrimination at the University, hence maintain an environment of social equality.

Caste discrimination complaints can also be made through Caste Discrimination Complaint Register maintained at the office of Faculty Deans

The following committee will examine the issues related to the caste discrimination complaints received from SC/ST/OBC students/teachers/non-teaching staff.
