Certificate Course in Esthetic Dentistry



Duration of Course: 1 year

Number of Admissions: 4 candidates per batch (Jan and June)

Eligibility: BDS/MDS from DCI recognized Dental Institute or other Equivalent Degree recognized by DCI.

Program Overview:

The course aims to facilitate students to perform smile analysis, diagnose and recommend a treatment plan for patients desiring esthetic treatment. The student learns to provide comprehensive esthetic dental care utilizing new techniques and materials. The course experiences include reviews of esthetic and related literature, didactic presentations, laboratory & clinical experience and optimized esthetic dental care for the patient.

The participants will also exhibit clinical competence in the diagnosis and plan the treatment for patients desiring esthetic make over. They will perform simple to more extensive smile enhancement by means of teeth whitening, direct composite restorations, porcelain laminate veneers, all-ceramic and PFM crowns.
