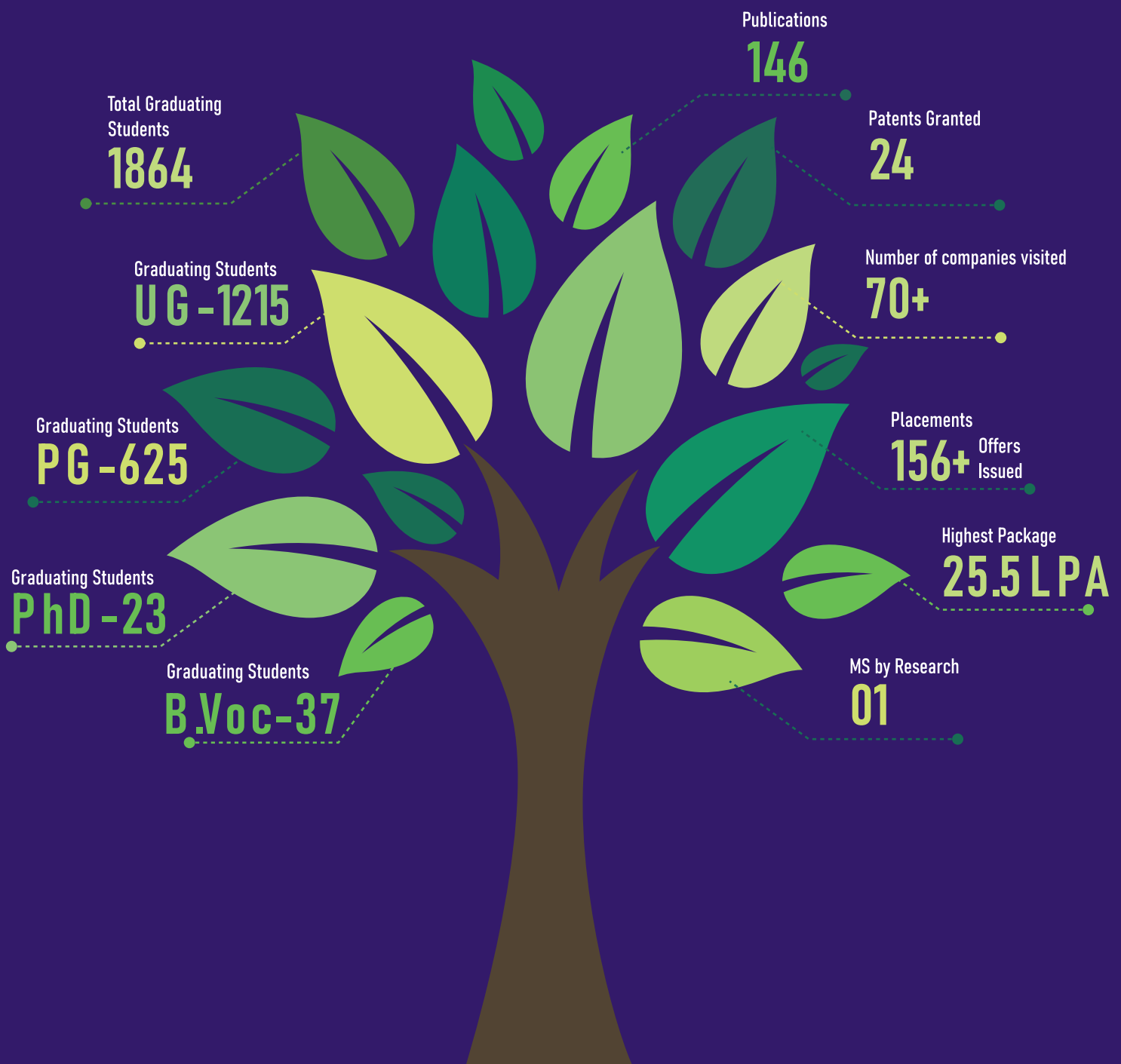

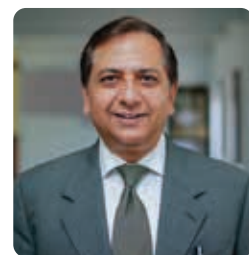

1.b) M.S.RUAS hosted the 37th Pierre Fauchard Academy Annual Conference, Convocation and Awards Ceremony on 9th December 2023. 1.10 Best Practices

Few faculties and departments have taken few initiatives as best practices that are at par with renowned educational institutions across the globe.

M.S.Ramaiah Institute of Nursing Education and Research has adopted distinct teaching pedagogies such as Index cards, Peer discussion, Case study and Flipped classroom. The Faculty is also adopting unique assessment criteria to evaluate students such as OSCE, flip chart on breast feeding, assessment of dehydration, diet plan for nephrotic syndrome, video on restraints for children, flex clip on Neonatal Resuscitation.

School of Social Sciences and School of Law developed Student Handbooks that provide comprehensive knowledge about University academic operations. Importantly, students have signed and submitted Honour Code forms as a commitment to the values of our University. The Schools also have a system of capacity building of the faculty in teaching and research such as case based teaching, setting question papers based on blooms taxonomy, use of LMS and research methods. Further, School of Social Sciences and School of Law have set up Social Science Research Collective, an initiative to encourage and strengthen inter-disciplinary research ecosystem.

Certain new courses were started titled “Pharmaceutical Development and Manufacturing” and PGDFM for enhancing career opportunities.

The department of Food Technology, FLAHS initiated collaborations in academics and research activity which culminated in signing a MoU between RUAS and CSIR-Central Food Technological Research Institute, Mysuru on 10th December 2023.

2. Research and Innovation

2.1 Sponsored Research Grants

Furthermore, sponsored research grants often have specific objectives aligned with the grant agency's priorities or societal needs. By securing these grants, universities can address pressing challenges in areas such as healthcare, energy, environment, and social sciences. This targeted research helps universities contribute to the betterment of society and facilitates collaborations with external organizations, including industry partners and government agencies. Sponsored research grants from reputed grant agencies are of paramount importance to drive innovation, enhance institutional reputation, and MSRUAS to contribute meaningfully to society.

In the last quarter the staff members from Faculty of Engineering and Technology, Faculty of Life and Allied Health Sciences, School of Social Sciences have received total research grant upto 4 Crores from reputed awarding agencies and for the most advanced and socially relevant research topics. The significant observation is the interdisciplinary research focus.

2.2 Promotion of Research and Innovation

Office of Research and Innovation organized collaborative workshops and programs to empower the academia.

- a) **Science Communication Workshop:** In partnership with Kannada University, Hampi, a collaborative effort involved 43 participants from various locations across the state, including RUAS. - b) **Activities under IIC RUAS -Ramaiah Hackathon 2023 (SIH 2023) - 13th Sept 2023:** The Internal Hackathon was organized with the primary objective of identifying and selecting teams that would represent RUAS in the prestigious Smart India Hackathon (SIH) 2023 competition. This event served as a catalyst for promoting innovation, teamwork, and problem-solving skills among our faculties and students, aligning them with the broader goal of preparing for the challenges presented in the SIH-2023.

The hackathon provided a dynamic platform for participants to collaborate, brainstorm, and devise creative solutions to real-world problems. Teams engaged in intensive coding sessions, leveraging their diverse skill sets and expertise to address the challenges posed during the event. The emphasis was not only on technical proficiency but also on fostering a collaborative spirit and encouraging out-of-the-box thinking.

Through the Internal Hackathon, participants honed their abilities to work under time constraints and pressure, simulating the competitive environment they would encounter in the SIH-2023. The event not only identified teams with the potential to represent RUAS at a national level but also contributed to the overall development of participants by enhancing their problem-solving and innovation skills.

By aligning with the goals of the Smart India Hackathon, RUAS demonstrated its commitment to nurturing a culture of innovation and preparing its academic community to excel in national-level competitions, fostering an environment that values creativity and collaborative problem-solving.

a) Social Responsibility-“We Care”

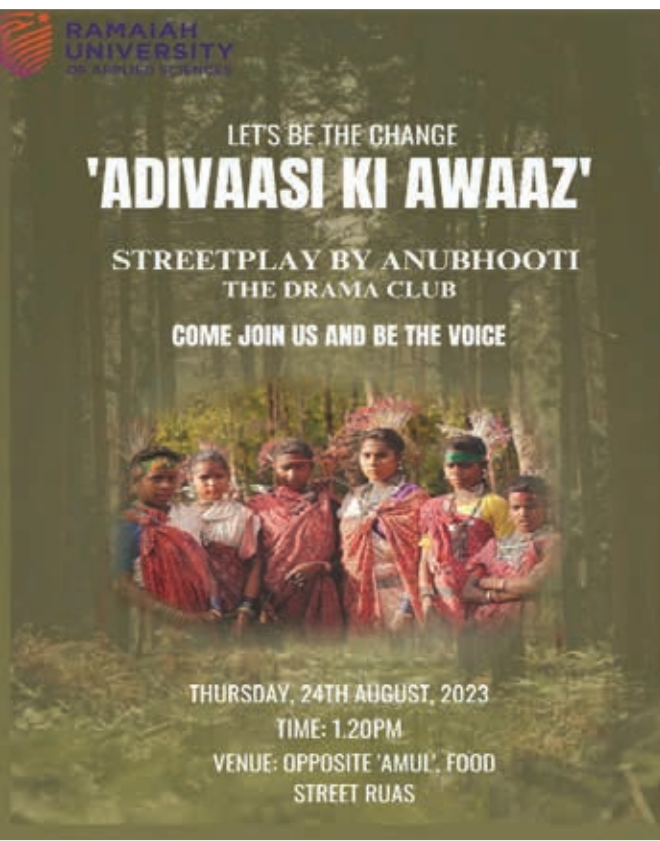

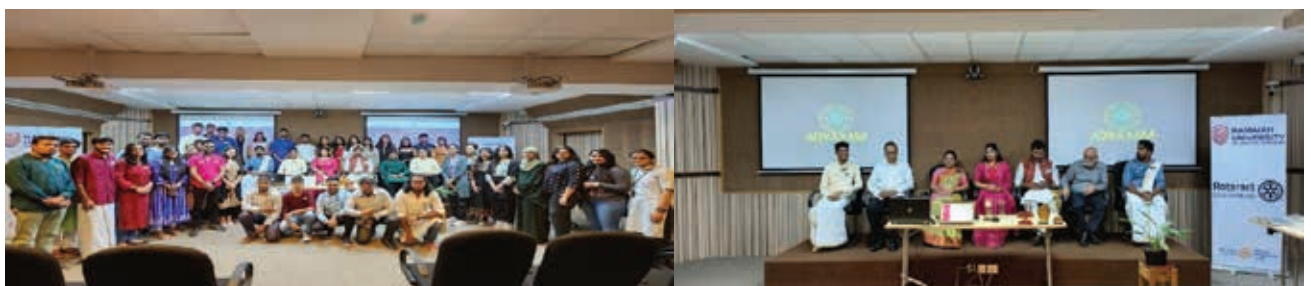
