Seats are limited. The early bird fee is ₹8,000 (plus taxes) **until January 17, 2025**; thereafter, it will be ₹10,000 (plus taxes). The fee covers all sessions, workshop materials, lunch, and refreshments on-site. Partial fee waivers may be available for deserving candidates and doctoral scholars (entrepreneurship and allied fields) in later stages of their PhD. Participants need to make their own travel arrangements.

Accommodation

On-campus accommodation for outstation participants is available on request but is subject to limited availability. Charges shall be borne by participants as per the actuals.

Certificate of Participation

A certificate of participation will be issued to the participants who complete the program.

Based on their participation and interest, select participants may receive a partial fee waiver to attend the Price Babson Symposium for Entrepreneurship Educators (held at Babson College, USA) or the Studio for Entrepreneurship Educators Asia 2025 (conducted online).
