The following are the proceedings of the programme:

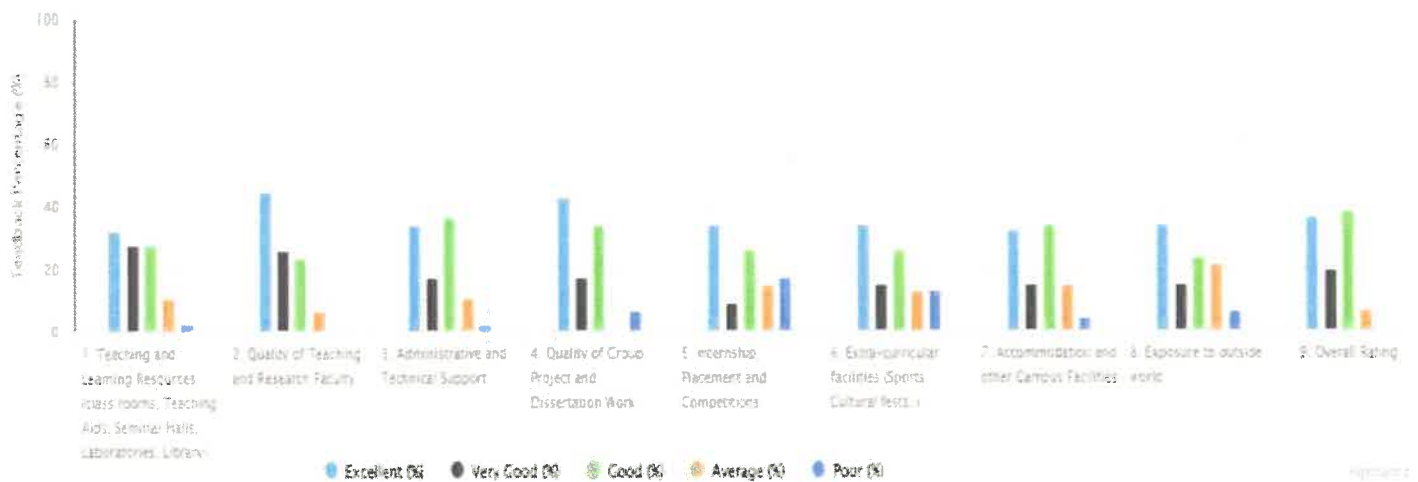
