1. The committee assesses the quality index of all Faculties, Departments, Programmes, Courses offered considering teaching, learning, student experience, brand value and value for money.
2. The committee obtains feedback from Students, Academic Faculty and Non-Academic Faculty, Parents of the Students, Alumni and Employers of the Students at the end of each academic year. The feedback data is entered into a quality index computing software for the determination of quality index.
3. The committee members are Head QCs of all Faculties and Chief QC is the chair of the committee, one of the Head QCs will act as secretary of the committee on a rotation basis. Other members of the committee are nominated by the respective Deans from each department or Faculty on an annual basis.
4. The committee submits the report to University Performance Review Committee for action.

Proctoral System

The University has implemented the Proctoral System to guide the students periodically on registration for credits, their studies, review of attendance and performance, reporting the attendance and performance to the parents. The University ensures that there is at least one Proctor for every 20 Undergraduate students.

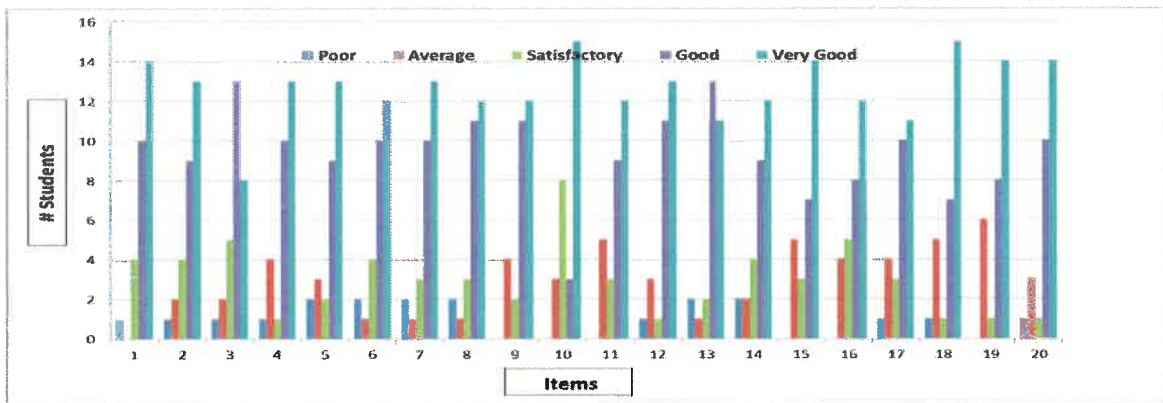
