The response of course feedback form consist of 5 options as 1- Poor, 2-Average, 3-Satisfactory, 4- Good, 5- Very good.

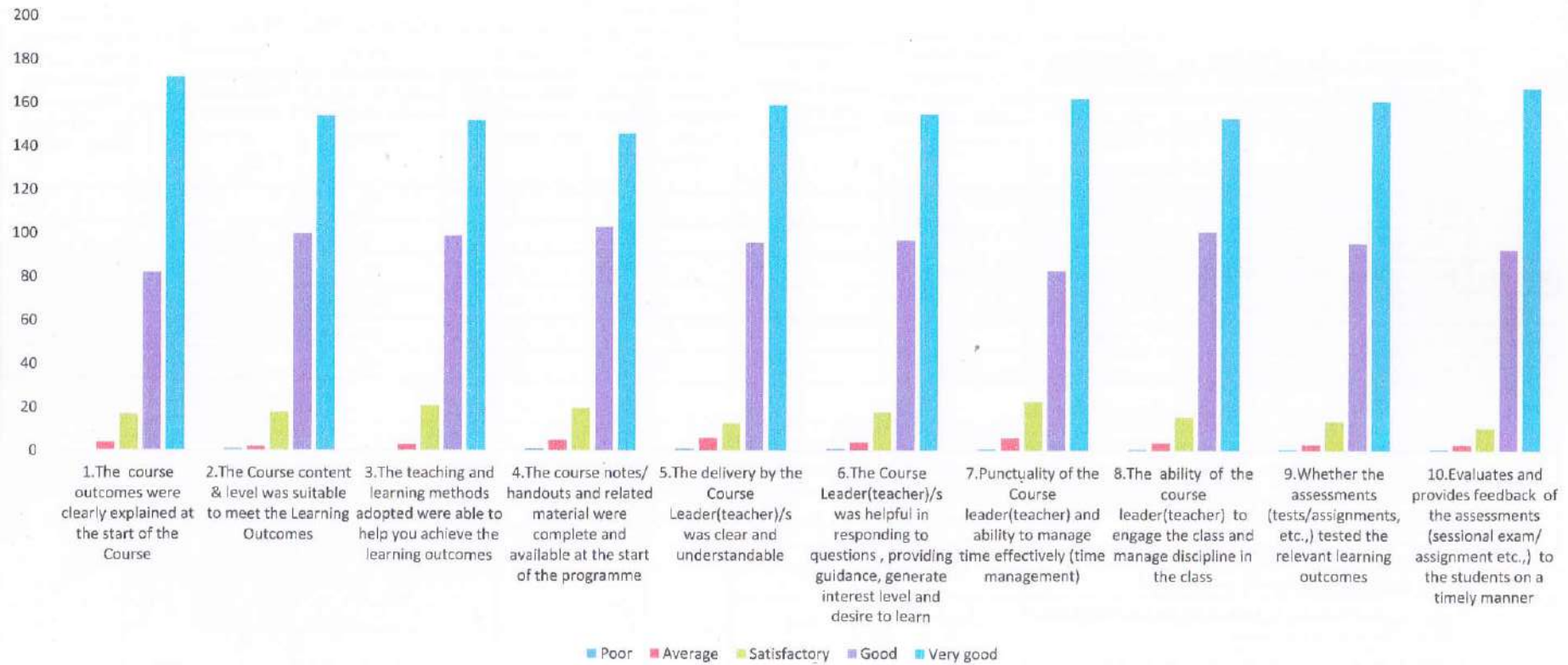

Student Feedback on overall courses(subjects)




