**Report on the Eighth Parade Class for NCC Cadets**

To conduct a structured NCC parade and drill training session to enhance discipline, coordination, and marching skills among cadets.

## Proceedings

1. The parade session began with the **formal reporting** of the parade to the Parade Commander, followed by necessary instructions regarding discipline and safety.

  - **Saj Dayen Saj** – practiced to enhance turning accuracy and coordination.
  - **Tej Chal** – executed to develop speed and rhythm in marching.
  - Additional parade movements and commands were practiced to reinforce drill fundamentals.
5. Continuous guidance and corrections were provided by the instructor to ensure precision and uniformity during the drills.
6. Cadets actively participated and followed all commands with discipline and attentiveness throughout the session.

## Observations

- Cadets demonstrated a high level of discipline and enthusiasm.
- Noticeable improvement was observed in formation control, foot coordination, and command response.
- The overall turnout and participation of cadets were satisfactory.

## Issues Discussed

- Minor corrections were required in line spacing and turning movements, which were addressed during the training.

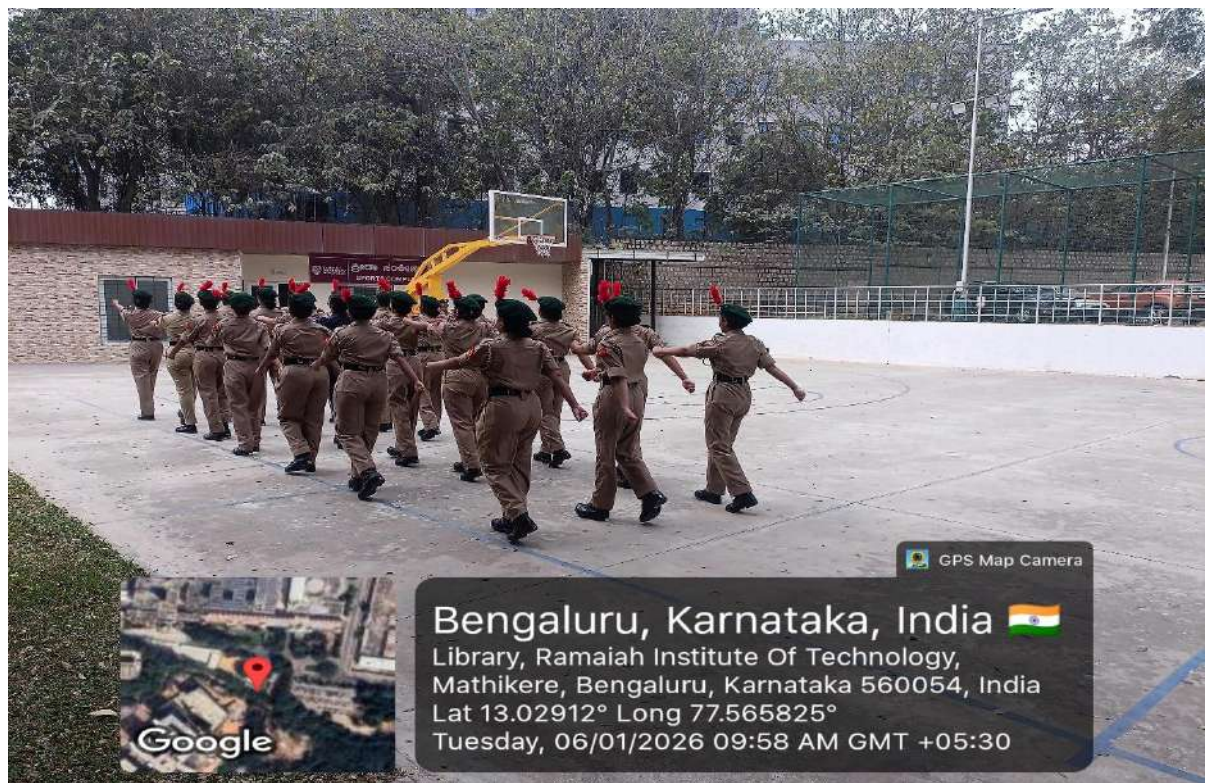
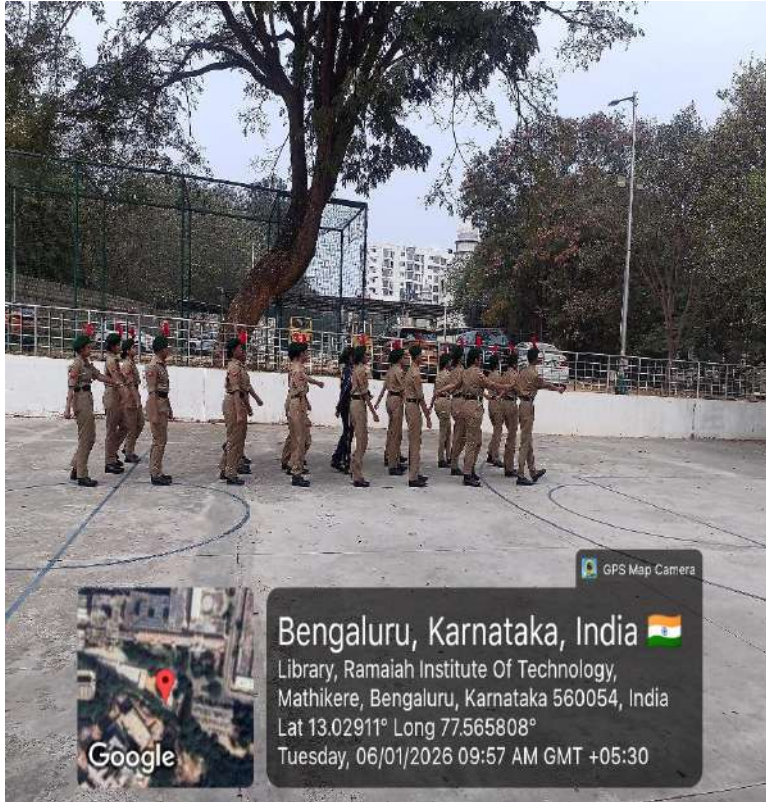
## Conclusion

The NCC parade and drill training session was conducted successfully, achieving its objective of improving drill efficiency and discipline among cadets.

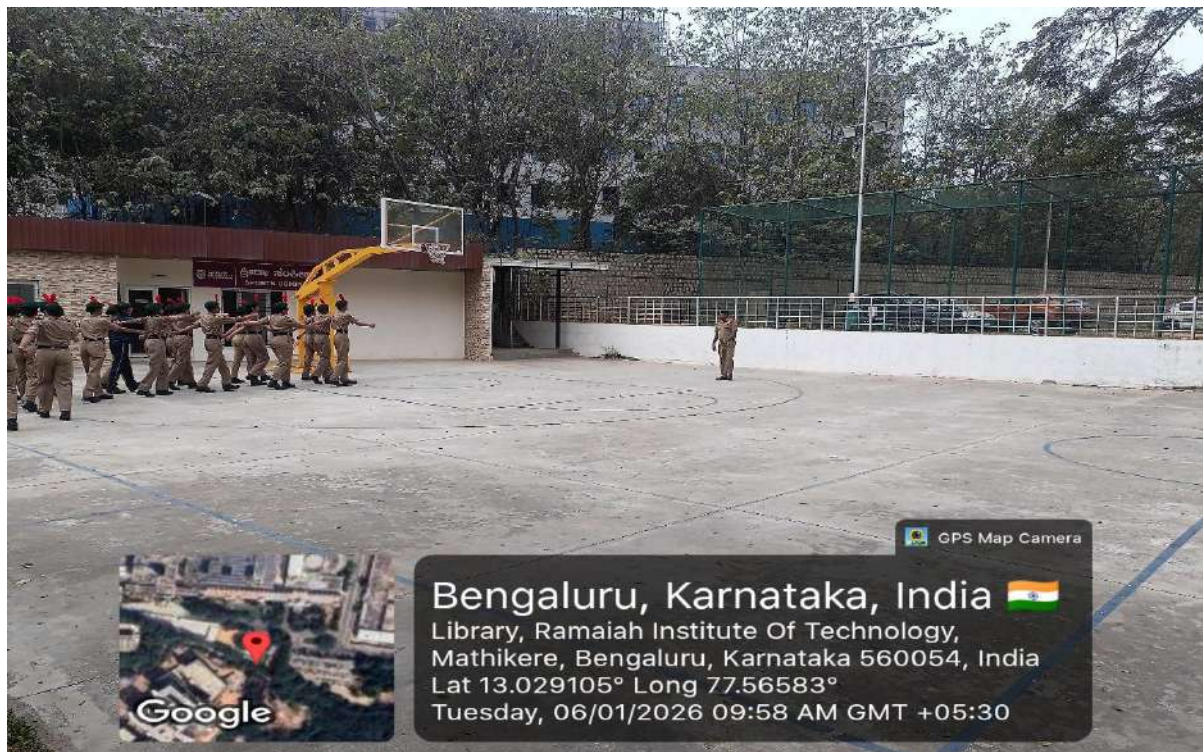
## Action Taken / Future Plan

- Special focus will be given to improving precision in turns and maintaining uniform spacing.

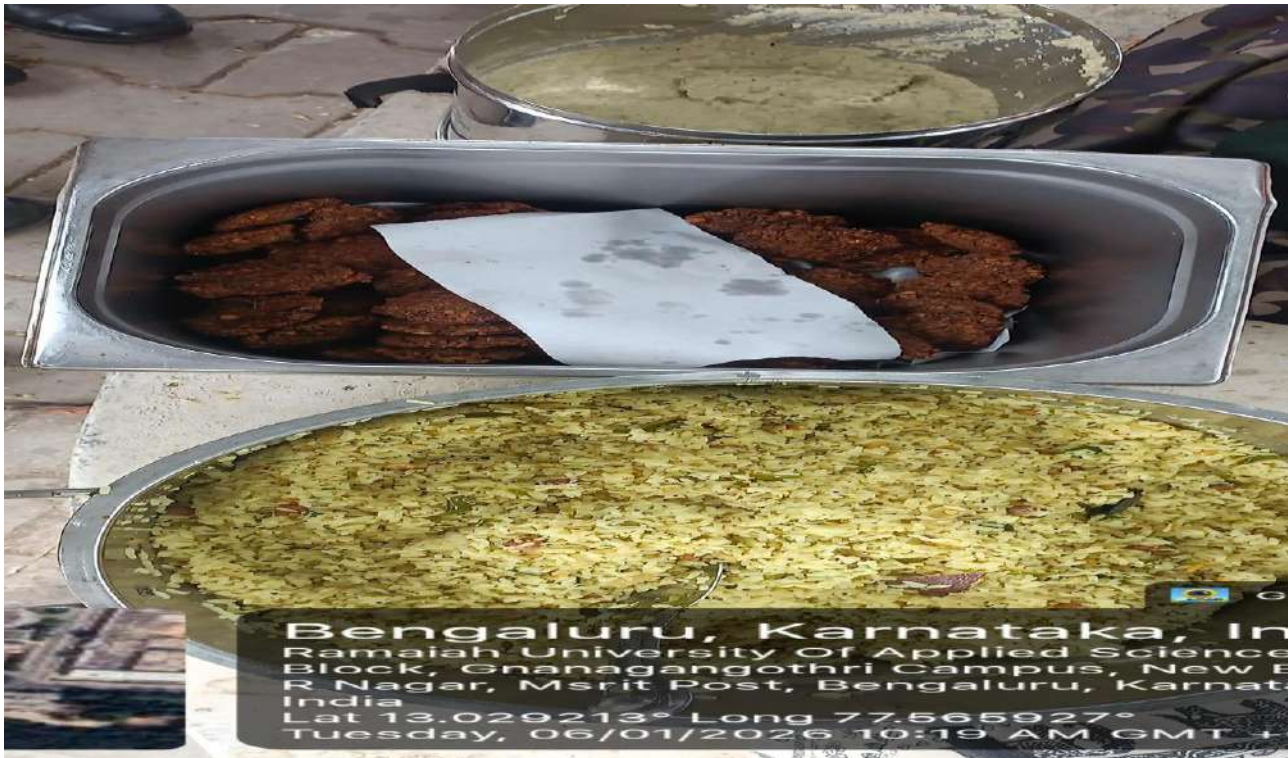
