

2	Students must have scored overall ≥ 8.0 CGPA or equivalent in qualifying undergraduate university examinations and must have passed all the examinations in the first attempt (M Tech/M Pharm).	40,000
3	Students must have scored overall $\geq 80\%$ or ≥ 8.0 CGPA in qualifying for undergraduate university examinations and must have passed all the examinations in the first attempt (MD/MS/MDS)	40,000
4	Students must have scored overall $\geq 75\%$ in qualifying Postgraduate university examinations and must have passed the examination in the first attempt (DM/M. Ch)	40,000

General conditions:

- a) All scholarships are applicable to Academic Year **2026-27** only.
- b) Only one Scholarship can be claimed by a given student, based on his/her preference.
- c) The Home State of the students for the State Based Scholarship is decided by Adhaar Card/Passport.
- d) The scholarships are based on merits and at the discretion of the Management. Hence, the same cannot be claimed as a matter of right by any student/parent.
- e) The above scholarships are for the students who have not availed any other concessions/ scholarship or reduced fee from the Govt/ other bodies.
- f) The continuation of the scholarship under the above schemes in the subsequent Academic Years is subject to maintenance of suitable academic performance as may be specified from time to time and the decision of the University.
- g) The continuation of the scholarship under the above schemes in the subsequent Academic Years is subject to maintenance of –
 - 1) A minimum CGPA of 8.0 and above during the immediately completed year of study scored out of the first offered attempt;
 - 2) No shortage of attendance during the immediately completed year of study; and
 - 3) No disciplinary action should have been taken or the student should not have found guilty on any count of misconduct.
