



Department of Prosthodontics and Crown & Bridge organized a Value Added Course titled 'Composites Made Easy' from 3rd to 7th February 2025. The event aimed to provide in-depth knowledge and hands-on experience on various composite restoration techniques used in modern dentistry. The course featured Dr. Manikya Arabolu, a Clinical Specialist for 3M Oral Care in South India. With an MDS in Prosthodontics and extensive experience in restorative dentistry, she has conducted over 600 workshops across South India. The course included a demonstration and hands-on session on midline closure using the direct composite technique, conducted by Dr. Manikya Arabolu. And a demonstration and hands-on session on core build-up for root canal treated teeth and rubber dam isolation, facilitated by Dr. Rhea Matthew & Dr. Shruthika Mahajan.
