The National Oral Cancer Conference (NOCC) 2025 was successfully conducted on 17th December 2025, organized by the Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Pathology and Oral Microbiology and the Oral Cancer Research Centre, FDS, RUAS was successfully concluded in Dwaraka Auditorium, with over 460 participants attending from across India and international locations including Nepal and Saudi Arabia. Centered on the theme “Current Trends in Oral Cancer – Diagnosis, Investigations & Management,” The conference was graced by esteemed university leadership, including Dr. Kuldeep Kumar Raina, Vice Chancellor, RUAS, and Mr. S. Ashok Rao, Registrar, RUAS, along with eminent speakers, Dr. Srinivas K, Consultant Oral Physician and Dental Surgeon, Manipal Hospital, Bengaluru- on the management of leukoplakia and lichen planus, Dr. Nadimul Hoda, Head, Department of Oral Oncology, Kidwai Memorial Institute of Oncology, Bengaluru- on oral cancer and its management, and Dr. Radhika M. MASTERING ORTHOGNATHIC SURGERY

- Importance of precise planning in orthognathic surgery for predictable outcomes.
- Role of interdisciplinary collaboration between oral surgeons and orthodontists.
- Exposure to real clinical scenarios through case discussions enhanced problem-solving skills.
- Emphasis on patient-specific treatment approaches rather than generalized protocols.

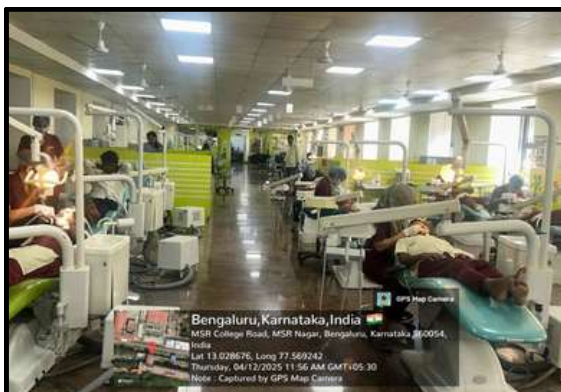
