Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter No.MSRDC/2001/0109, dated 8.6.2001 accepting the conditions of Letter of Intent issued by this Ministry on 25.5.2001 and to convey the formal permission of the Central Govt. under Section 10A(4) of Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 for starting of MDS course in the specialty of Conservative Dentistry with an intake capacity of 2 (Two) from the academic session 2001-2002 at M.S. Ramaiah Dental College, Bangalore.

2. This permission is granted for a period of one year, i.e., admitting one batch for 2001-02 only and will be renewed on yearly basis after verification of the achievements of the annual targets and revalidation of the performance bank guarantee given by you for Rs.60.00 lakhs.

3. The admission for 2nd batch will be made only after renewal of permission by the Central Government. In case any admissions are made in violation of this condition, such admissions would be treated as irregular and action under Section 10B of the Act would be initiated.
